Communication for Lactation Consultants

Goal

Integrate active listening and empowering words and phrases into therapeutic conversations and help clients to deal with outside criticism.

Objectives

- Recognize examples of "judging" words/phrases and their impact on maternal confidence and effective conversations.
- Classify examples of the professional's responses as agreeing, disagreeing or accepting and how those responses affect the next steps of the conversation.
- Given several sentences in the form of a command, re-write the statements in the form of a suggestion.
- Briefly describe the key to building the mother's confidence.
- Recognize examples of mistakes in active listening.
- Integrate principles of adult education and give relevant information using suitable language.
- Discuss strategies the mother can use if friends and family criticize her.
- Recognize definitions and examples for at least 5 terms related to communication.
